

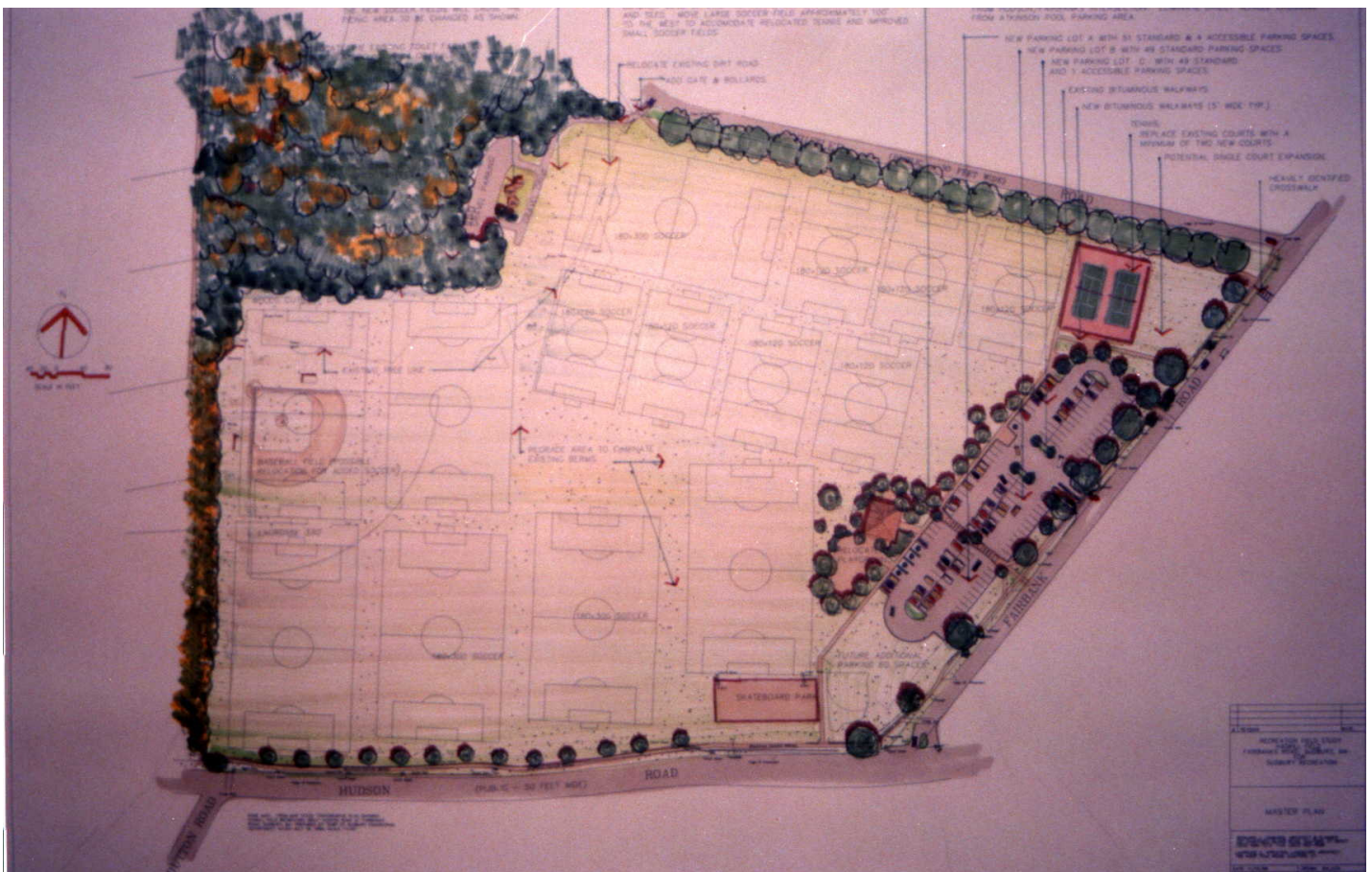
### HASKILL FIELD MASTER PLAN, Sudbury MA

Maximizing fields and flexibility in field orientation to allow “resting” of turf were the paramount objectives to reach in the Haskill Field Master Plan. Other important objectives were provision of an additional soccer field, a new lacrosse field and a picnic grove. Further, a need to separate pedestrian and vehicular traffic was evident. The field layouts proposed recognize the need to reorient fields to allow resting the turf around goals and resting full fields. The redesign did not attempt to initiate any major regrading of the field complex since the current drainage is satisfactory and an irrigation system exists. The Master Plan is designed to allow improvements as staged construction.

The format of the proposed plan is such that it can be broken into several construction stages so that small moves could produce large dividends without serious long term disruption. For a facility the size and complexity of Haskill Field, achievement of the program in a series of moves is a major planning success.

The Master Plan provides one lacrosse field; five adult soccer fields; seven youth soccer fields; two tennis courts; one baseball diamond; relocated and expanded parking; auxiliary parking; a picnic grove; concession, storage and rest room facilities; a skateboard park and tot playground. A resting plan demonstrating alternate field layouts to allow renovation of heavy use goal areas was also provided.

Costs for Stage I facilities are estimated at \$221,000 with final stage costing an additional \$379,000. Several options were also proposed with construction cost of \$39,000.
